Staff and Student Bursaries

ACSI is pleased to announce the launch of a number of research bursaries for academic staff and postgraduate students working in the area of Canadian Studies within the island of Ireland.

For **2018**, these bursaries will be:

- 2 academic staff bursaries at €1,500 (one research and one teaching)
- 1 postgraduate bursary at €1,000 (research)

The bursaries are intended to assist with research costs and may be used for the purpose of conference attendance, travel, publication and the development of teaching courses, providing that there is a direct link to Canadian Studies.

Applicants are invited to submit a brief research proposal (1000 words) or teaching plan (1000 words) along with a CV and a covering letter to ACSI before **1st March 2018**. Applicants should outline how they intend to spend the bursary in the covering letter. Applications may be written in either English or French.

As a condition of these awards, we ask that successful recipients become (if not already) a member of ACSI, submit a short report following the completion of the project and present their research at either our biennial conference or one of our one-day symposiums. Please note that being based at an institution on the island of Ireland is a requirement.

The first round of these bursaries will be awarded at the ACSI conference April 2018, Waterford Institute of Technology.
